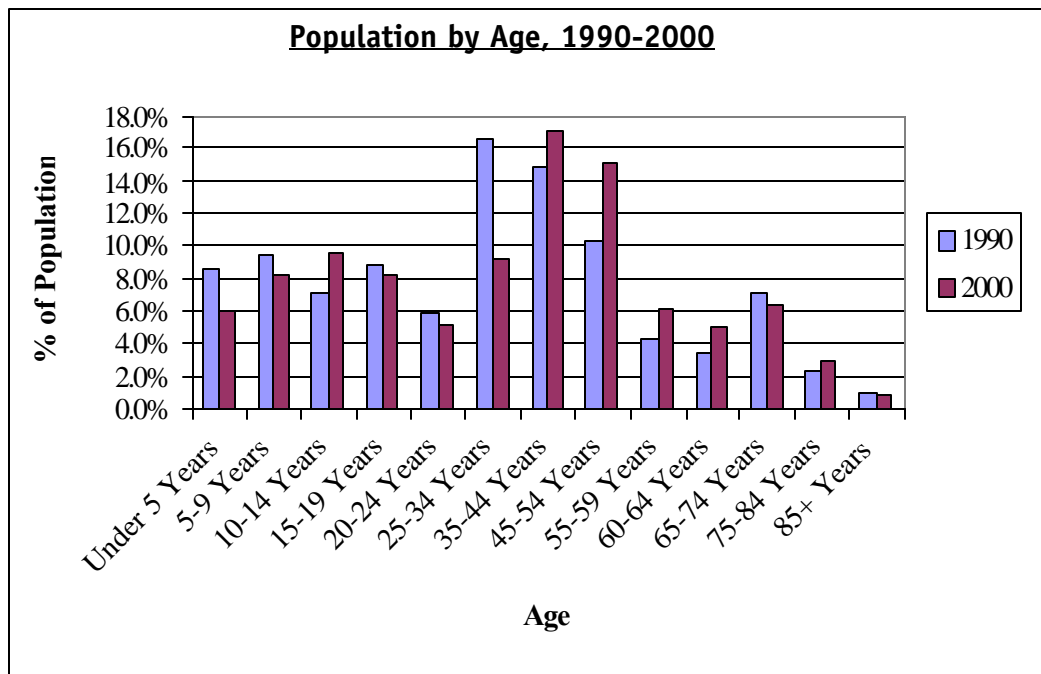

The population of the Town of Hollywood increased over 88 percent during the 1990's. Both the number of residents under the age of 18 and over the age of 65 increased by more than 85 percent. The number of residents over the age of 18 increased by almost 90 percent. The median age increased by 6.4 years over the last decade.

The number of households in the Town of Hollywood more than doubled during the 1990's, as did the number of married couple households and female householders with no husband present. The number of nonfamily households and householders living alone increased at a slightly higher rate.

Even so, both the average household and family sizes decreased by almost 10 percent. The number of persons per owner and renter occupied units declined, as well.
