

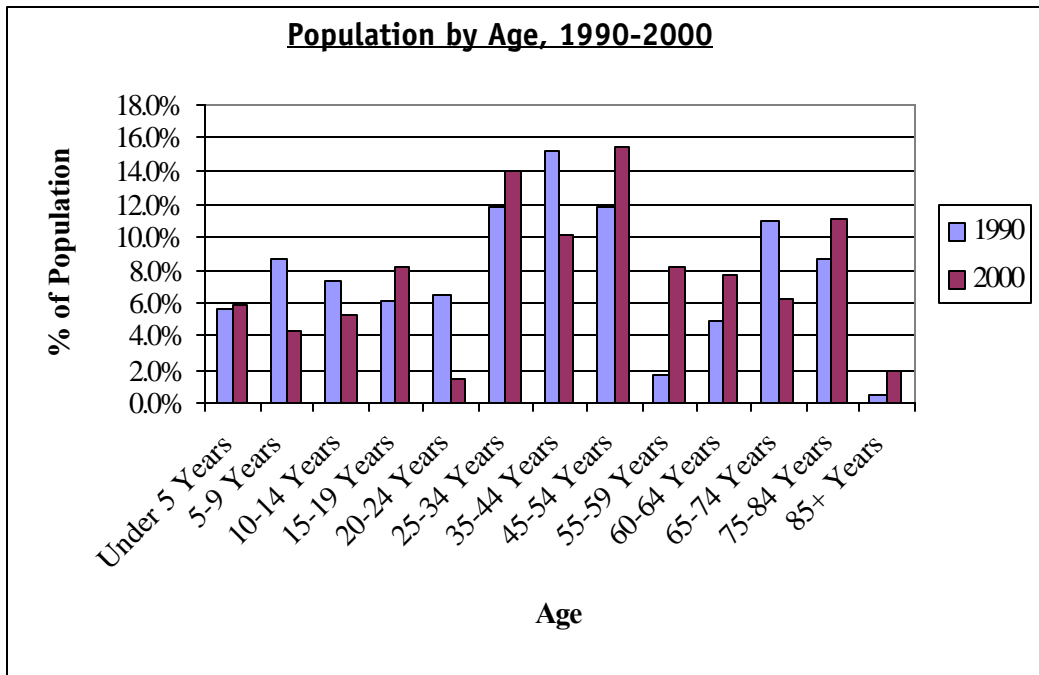

The Town of Reevesville experienced a 15.2 percent drop in population between 1990 and 2000. The male population declined at a higher rate than the female population did and the females comprised the majority of the population in 2000. The number of children under the age of 14 declined almost 40 percent, while the number of residents over the age of 65 dropped by just over 18 percent.

Other age groups that lost population included the 20 to 24 years, 35 to 44 years, and 65 to 74 years age categories. The population of persons under the age of 18 made up only 19 percent of the population in 2000, down from comprising 24 percent of the population in 1990.
