

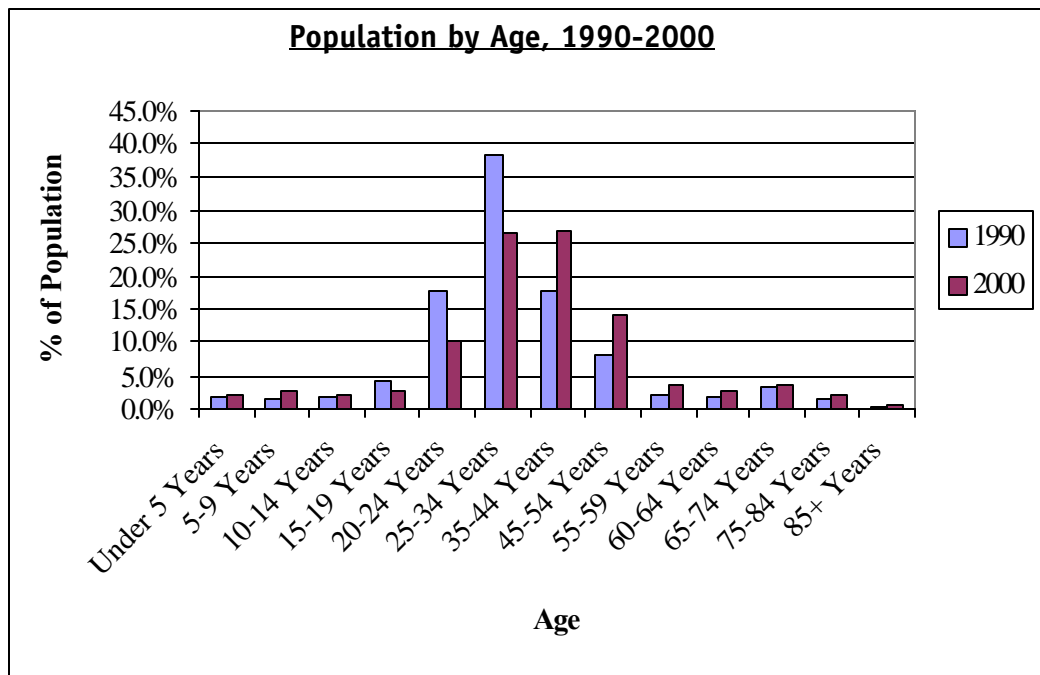

The population of the Town of Ridgeville increased 4 percent during the 1990's. Although the male population declined by just over 1 percent, it still comprised the majority of the population. This is due to the presence of a large all-male correctional facility. The Town lost the majority of its population (32 percent) in the 15 to 34 years age group. The population aged 65 years and older increased by just over 29 percent.

The median age increased by 6.2 years, to 36.2 years in 2000.

The Town of Ridgeville experienced a change in household composition over the last decade. The total number of households increased, as did the number of married couple households, children in households, and family and nonfamily households. The number of other relatives and nonrelatives in households both increased, as well. The number of female households with no husband present increased.

The average household size remained constant, while the average family size decreased more than 2 percent.
