

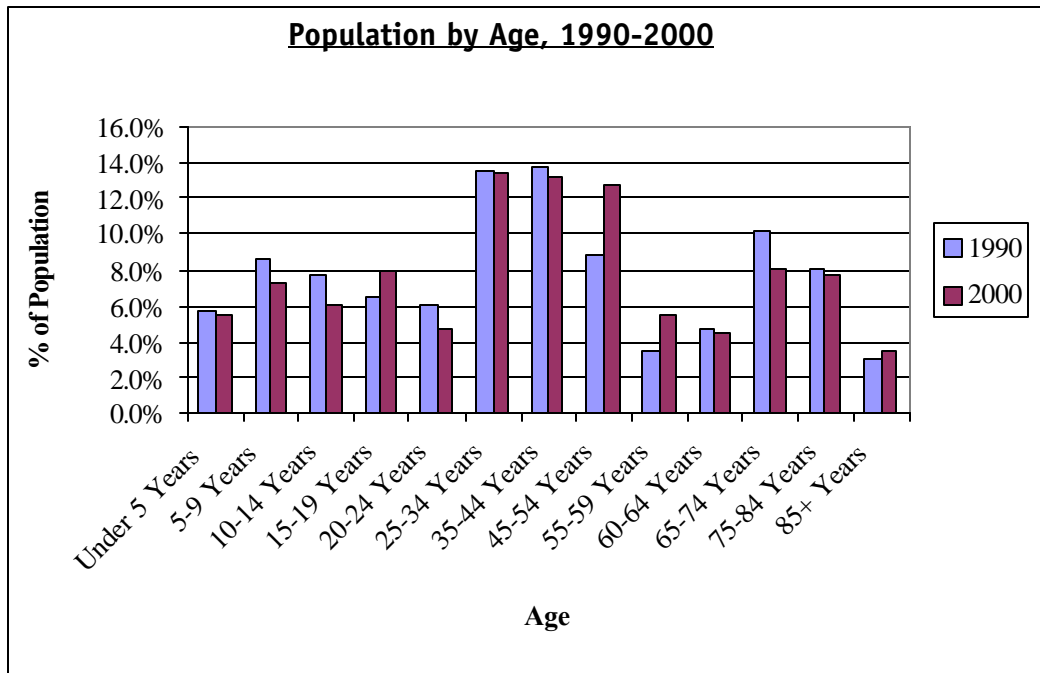

The population of the Town of St. George increased very slightly during the 1990's, by 0.7 percent. The female population dropped by 5 percent, but still comprised the majority of the population in 2000. The Town saw a decline of almost 14 percent in the number of children under the age of 14 years. The number of residents over the age of 65 declined, as well, although the population of residents 85 years and older increased. The number of persons aged 60 to 84 years decreased by almost 11 percent.

The median age increased slightly, by 2.4 years.

The household composition of the Town changed during the 1990's, as well. The number of married couple households, family households, and children in households declined. The number of female householders with no husband present also dropped, along with the average household and family sizes.

The number of other relatives and nonrelatives in households, as well as the number of nonfamily households increased, the former two by more than twice their 1990 number.
