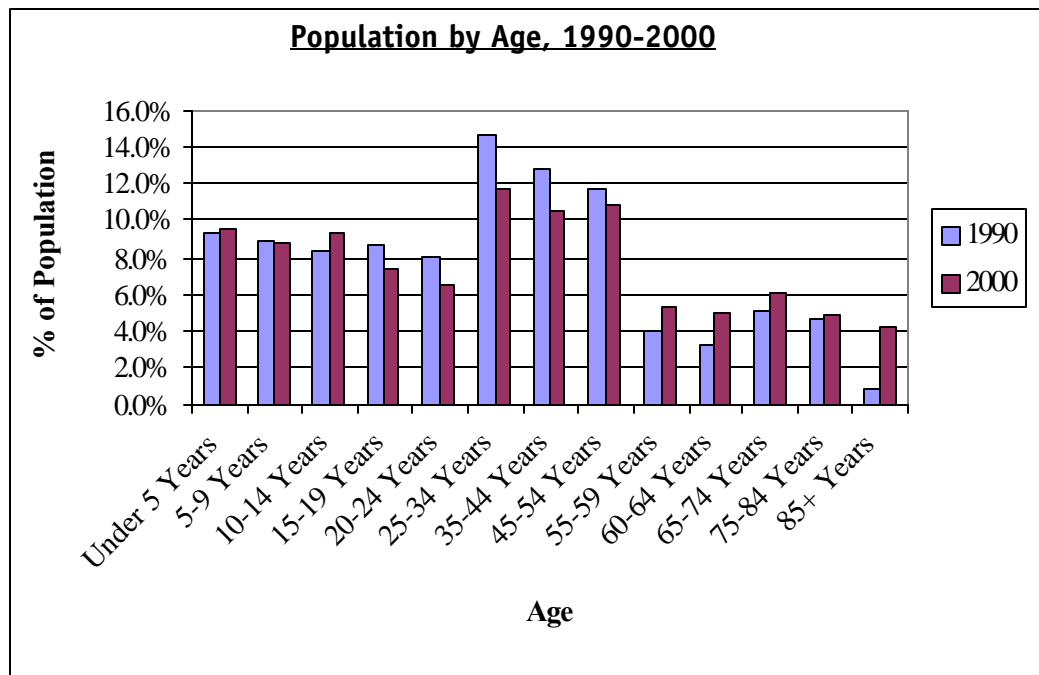

The population of the Town of St. Stephen increased by 4.7 percent during the 1990's. The Town saw the greatest population losses in the 25 to 34 years age group. In all, a drop of just over 12 percent was seen in the age groups ranging from 15 to 54 years of age. The number of persons 85 years and over increased by 5 times its 1990 size. The median age of the Town's residents increased by 2.8 years, from 29.3 years in 1990 to 32.1 years in 2000.

The number of persons living in households in the Town of St. Stephen declined slightly between 1990 and 2000. The number of married couple households, children in households, family households, and average household and family sizes all decreased, as well. The number of other relative and nonrelative households more than doubled in size and the number of nonfamily households increased by just over 22 percent.

The number of seasonal housing units declined by 50 percent, while the number of occupied housing units increased by 3.6 percent and the number of vacant units increased almost 39 percent.
