



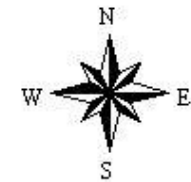


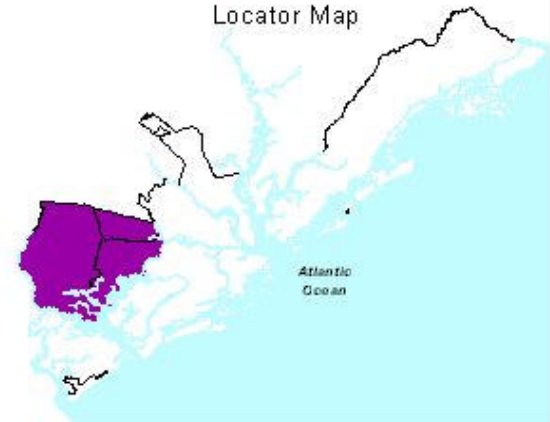
Map 1: Charleston County West Planning Area

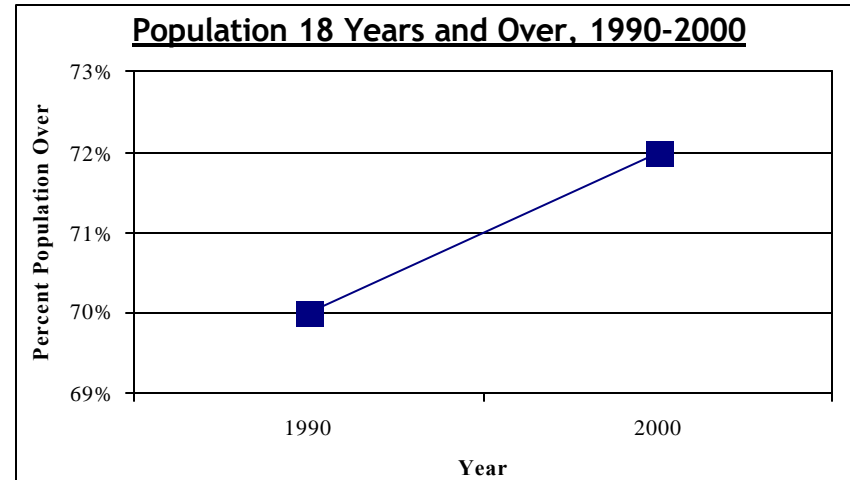
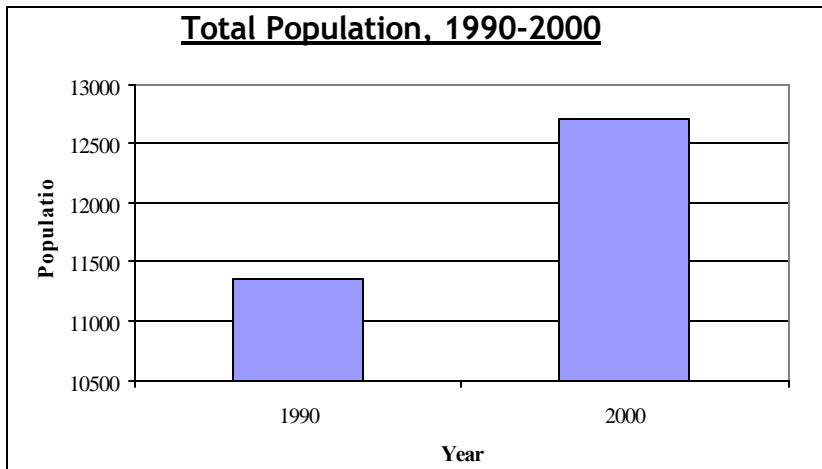

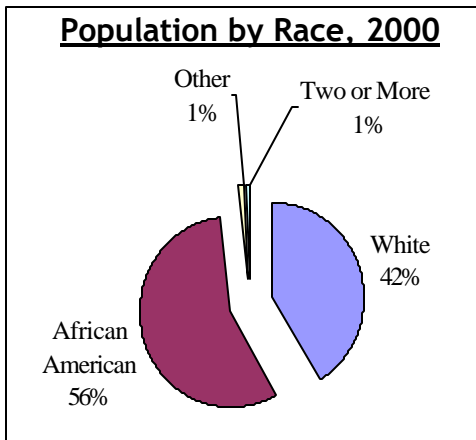

Charleston County West



Almost 13,000 people lived in the Charleston County West Planning Area in 2000. The population grew by more than 12 percent during the 1990's, an increase of more than 1,300 people.



With 1,200 more residents over the age of 18 in 2000 than in 1990, the population 18 years and older saw an increase of more than 15 percent.

In 1990, 36 percent of the population of Charleston County West was White and 64 percent was African American. By 2000, that proportion had shifted to 42 percent White and 57 percent African American. During the 1990's, the African American population decreased slightly, by less than 1 percent, while the White population increased by almost 29 percent. The "Other" population rose by 320 percent, increasing from 39 persons in 1990 to 164 persons in 2000.
