




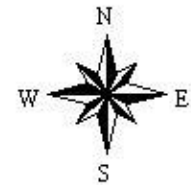
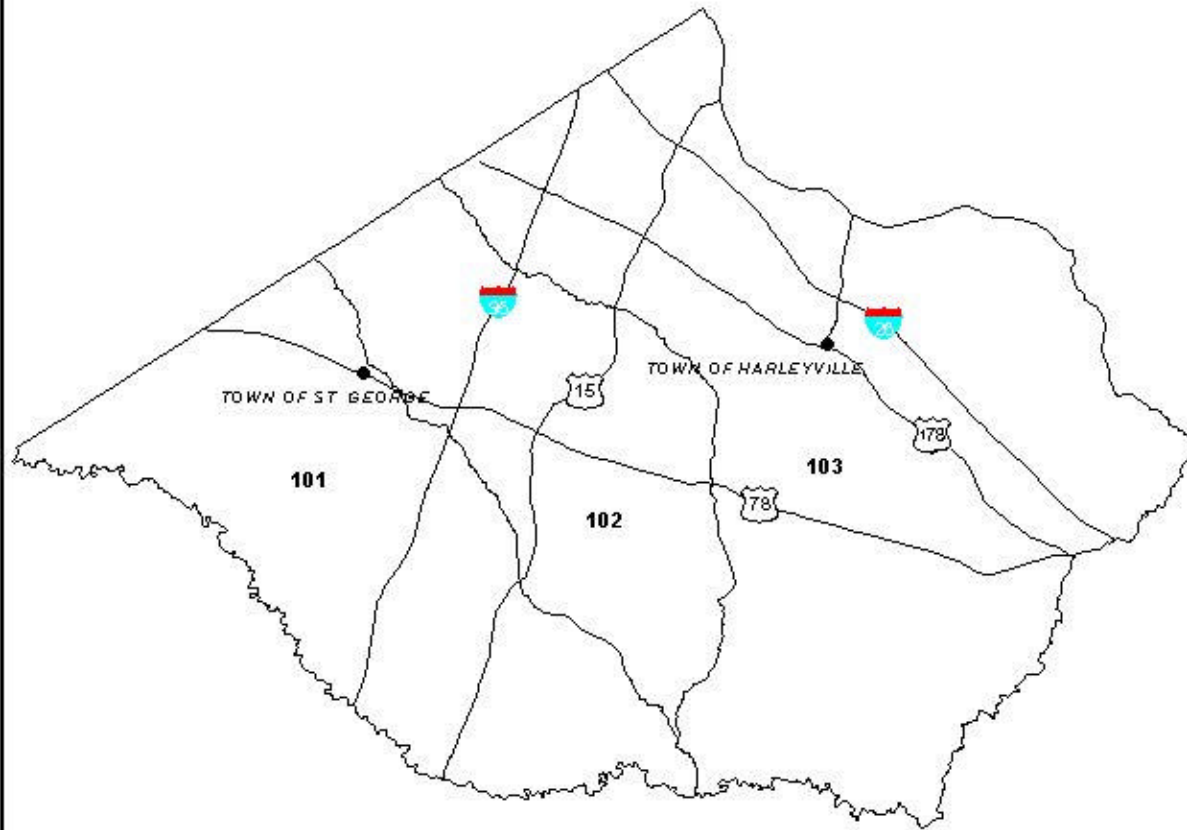


Map 1: St. George Planning Area

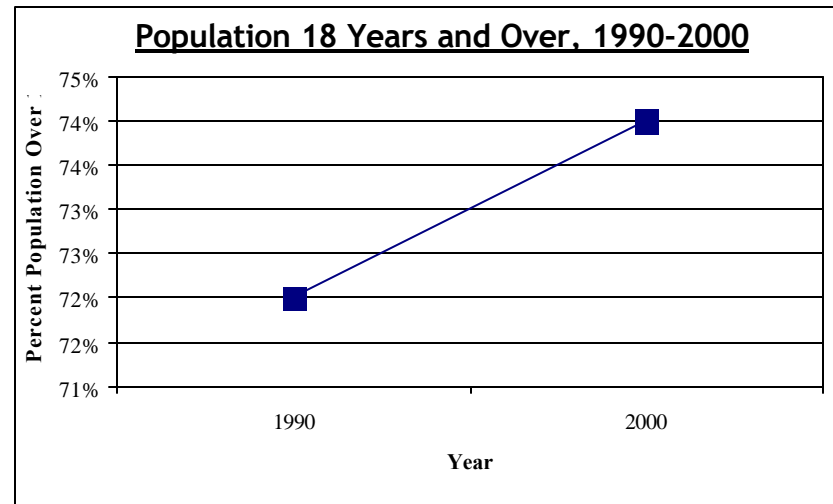
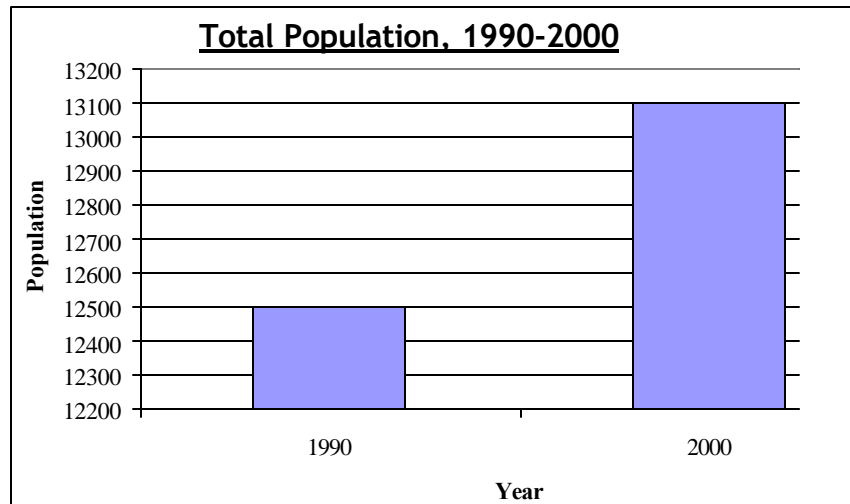

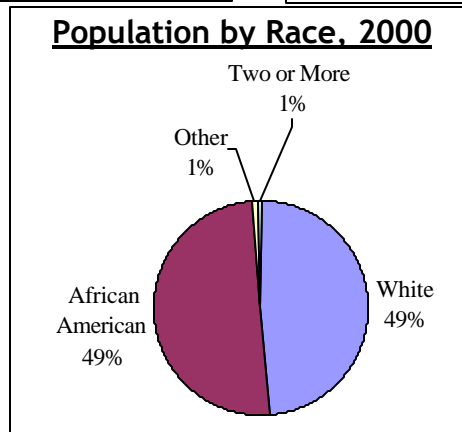
Locator Map

With a 2000 population of just over 13,000 people, the St. George Planning Area was the second smallest of the planning areas in Dorchester County. During the 1990's, its population increased by just under 600 people, or by 5 percent, the lowest percent increase in the County.



In 1990, 72 percent of the population was over the age of 18. By 2000, 74 percent was older than 18. There was increase of 7.8 percent in the number of persons over the age of 18 between 1990 and 2000.

The White population increased by 7 percent during the 1990's while the African American population increased by less than 1 percent. The "Other" population increased by 147 percent, rising from 47 persons in 1990 to 116 persons in 2000.
